Principal's Report – T. Sacco

The DSBN Accommodation Report is available at [www.DSBN.org/arcs](http://www.DSBN.org/arcs). 47 schools in the DSBN will be a part of the next year's Accommodation review. It is to be a 3 phase plan. CI will be considered in the first phase. By the end of the third phase, all municipalities will have participated. M. Hyatt is in charge of the review. In addition, J. Stainsby, J. Morgan, D. Durant and C. Thompson are DSBN representatives. Process will begin September 15. The first meeting will take place at Kernahan Park. The review committee will be made up of a student rep, principal, school council rep, business rep, political rep, trustee as well as the aforementioned DSBN reps. Ten meetings must be completed by February. Recommendations to the Board in April/May. Ultimately, the DSBN trustees will make the final decision. Declining enrollment, the economy, monies received from the Ministry for repairs and upkeep to school facilities are contributing factors to the need for accommodation reviews. In April/May recommendations for closure will be made. The earliest school closures would be February 2013. Total cost of the review is \$459,000. All reviews are expected to be completed in 3 years. T. Sacco has been selected as the secondary representative for the DSBN. Her role, however, is neutral in the process. At the September, Alumni meeting additional questions could be posed. On September 22, the first public meeting will take place.

As a result of the new transportation procedure, CI will begin classes in the new school year at 8:10 a.m.

The 90<sup>th</sup> school reunion is being planned for 2013.

Stride for Pride took place in May. Over \$4 000 was raised by CI and Queen Mary students.

CI graduation is June 29, 2011. 150 students are expected to graduate.

School Liaison – D. Douglas

D. Douglas reported that after conferring with S. Fralick and T. Ley the proposed Ron Sexsmith concert, a joint venture of the CI Music Department and Alumni, would take place in the fall of 2012. D. Douglas will follow up with T. Ley in the fall of 2011.

New Business

W. Gale raised the question of selecting a Chairperson for the 90<sup>th</sup> Reunion. This will be discussed and decided at the September 14, 2011 meeting.
